In this increasingly hectic world, taking an entire week off to attend a course is nearly impossible for many. We often hear from people who say they would like to either attend or bring someone to a weeklong Concentrated Course only to say that it just isn't possible because of their schedule.

Regardless of their busy schedules, people still expressed a desire to receive training in biblical discipleship/counseling. We at BCF recognized the need and developed weekend seminars as an attempt to provide this initial training. To our delight, the Lord has powerfully used the biblical truths taught in the seminars to change people's lives.

The Weekend Seminar is an introduction to the Self-Confrontation course and breaks the normal Concentrated Course into two parts. Part A covers the first 12 lessons in the Self-Confrontation manual, covering topics such as the Biblical foundation for change, the Biblical view of self, of anger, and of forgiveness. This allows students to have

a firm foundation on which they can finish the Self-Confrontation course on their own or in Part B of the Weekend Seminar. Part B deals with marriage problems, parent-child conflicts, depression, fear, anxiety, and life-dominating practices of sin.

For many, a Weekend Seminar is their first opportunity to see that God's Word truly holds the answers for all of life.

Many of the testimonies from Weekend Seminars are deeply moving. One woman remarked after attending the Weekend Seminar that her children had already said to her "What has happened to you? You are different now." She had already begun to practice God's Word.

Others testified as to how they had been convicted by the Lord of being critical, and of their plans to change.

In France, a Weekend Seminar


BCF IN-PERSON BOBBIE VAN SANT

We at BCF are humbled and grateful to the Lord for sending Bobbie to serve with us. She has blessed thousands over the years with her gifts and the Lord continues to use her daily to bless others in practical and helpful ways.

participant remarked, "This seminar has truly enlightened me . . . For a long time I have been afraid to go farther in my commitment . . . Today, this Weekend Seminar has confirmed my commitment to the church that I attend. Today I understand the connection we must not make between emotions and actions. I have also really understood that it is the Word that helps us raise our children. I must return to the Scriptures. This Self-Confrontation manual is a precious tool to turn us again to the Scriptures."

Last year, Weekend Seminars were held in California, Florida, Virginia, Ohio, Washington, and Texas. Additionally, outside the USA, Weekend Seminars were held in France.

Weekend Seminars are open to all who can attend. The cost to attend in the US is \$55, which includes materials. Additional members of the same household can attend for \$40 (no materials given). A \$5 discount is available to those who register more than a month before a seminar is held.

The following testimony was given by a participant who attended a Concentrated Course in Vienna, Virginia this past year

This course - rather God through this course - has caused me to look intently at His purpose for my life. Why He "saved" me. I am grieved that so much of my Christian life has been about what God can do for me. Yet, I am grateful that by His Spirit He is using His word to show me this life is about Him: His glory, conforming to the image of His Son, oneness with Him . . .

I think that I have lived my life around being "saved" and "going to heaven" but didn't know how to live between the two - so to speak. This course has made me aware of my responsibility in the sanctification process: confronting myself biblically and walking/obeying what He shows through His word.

This course came at a time when God has been bringing [people] from different walks of life to me. I hear the world's wisdom coming from them, excusing why they do what they do. I have been praying for God to show me how to clearly show His truth to bring deliverance/hope to them. This material has been so helpful. It relieves me knowing that I am not responsible for changing their hearts, but declaring the truth in gentleness and love.
